## 1 STANDUP

He's performed at 100+ colleges, through the National Association for Campus Activities (NACA) and many Indian/South Asian organizations. He has opened for Russell Peters more than any other Indian comedian. He even opened Dave Chappelle's very first show after his much-publicized African hiatus.

## 2 HOSTING

Rajiv can host an existing event of yours - anything from a dance competition to a talent show. He has his own talk show and podcast. He even hosted Indian PM Narendra Modi's program in San Jose, California, in front of 17,000 people. He can spice up your day/night, properly introducing performers/presenters and sprinkling in funny comments that keep the audience engaged.

He recently gave a TEDx Talk and a Talk@Google. Rajiv's keynote topics include Diversity, Innovation/Risk-Taking, Humor, and Personal Branding.
